PROCLAMATION NO. 1110

DECLARING WEDNESDAY, 2 SEPTEMBER 2015, AS A SPECIAL (NON-  
WORKING) DAY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBAY

**WHEREAS**, Wednesday, 2 September 2015, marks the 150<sup>th</sup> birth anniversary of the late General Simeon A. Ola, the last revolutionary general to surrender at the end of the Philippine-American War;

**WHEREAS**, it is but fitting and proper that the people of the Province of Albay be given full opportunity to participate and celebrate the occasion with appropriate ceremonies.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, PAQUITO N. OCHOA, JR.**, Executive Secretary, by authority of His Excellency, **BENIGNO S. AQUINO III**, do hereby declare Wednesday, 2 September 2015, as a special (non-working) day in the Province of Albay.


**IN WITNESS WHEREOF**, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.
