

Please take notice that the Court, First Division, issued a Resolution dated August 10, 2015 which reads as follows:


“G.R. No. 214443 (People of the Philippines v. Agosto Acyawan y Abance). – The accused-appellant’s supplemental brief in compliance with the Resolution dated November 17, 2014 is NOTED.

After a judicious perusal of the records, the Court resolves to **DISMISS** the appeal for failure to sufficiently show that the Court of Appeals (CA) committed any reversible error in the assailed Decision as to warrant the exercise of the Court’s appellate jurisdiction.

WHEREFORE, the Court **ADOPTS** the findings of fact and conclusions of law in the October 25, 2013 Decision¹ of the CA in CA-G.R. CR HC No. 05267 and **AFFIRMS** said Decision finding accused-appellant Agosto Acyawan y Abance **GUILTY** beyond reasonable doubt of Illegal Possession of Dangerous Drugs in violation of Section 11, Article II of Republic Act No. 9165,² otherwise known as the “Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002,” sentencing him to suffer the penalty of life imprisonment and to pay a fine of ₱5,000,000.00.
