Please take notice that the Court, First Division, issued a Resolution dated January 19, 2021 which reads as follows:

After a judicious review of the Petition and its annexes, the Court finds that the Petition lacks merit as it failed to show that the Court of Appeals (CA) committed any reversible error in denying the petition for *certiorari*.

The CA was correct when it found that petitioner was not constructively dismissed and that she failed to present evidence to support her allegations. The findings of the CA, which affirmed the National Labor Relations Commission, both of which are supported by substantial evidence, are binding on the Court.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, the Court resolves to **DENY** the Petition and **AFFIRM** the Decision¹ dated December 6,
