REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7673

- AN ACT TO DECLARE THE SEVENTEENTH DAY OF SEPTEMBER OF EVERY YEAR AS A NONWORKING SPECIAL PUBLIC HOLIDAY FOR THE PROVINCE OF SIQUIJOR TO BE KNOWN AS SIQUIJOR DAY
- Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:
- SECTION 1. Republic Act No. 6398 which created Siquijor Island into a province was enacted and signed by then President Ferdinand E. Marcos on September 17, 1971.
- SEC. 2. The seventeenth day of September of every year is hereby declared a nonworking special public holiday for the Province of Siquijor to be known as Siquijor Day.
- SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

Lapsed into law on January 10, 1994 without the President's signature, pursuant to Sec. 27(1), Article VI of the Constitution.
