AN ACT AMENDING REPUBLIC ACT NO. 9094, ENTITLED
"AN ACT DECLARING THE SEVENTH (7TH) DAY OF
JANUARY OF EVERY YEAR AS A SPECIAL WORKING
PUBLIC HOLIDAY IN THE PROVINCE OF CAMIGUIN
TO BE KNOWN AS 'ARAW NG CAMIGUIN' "

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Republic Act No. 9094, otherwise known as "An Act Declaring the Seventh (7th) Day of January of Every Year as a Special Working Public Holiday in the Province of Camiguin to be known as 'Araw ng Camiguin'", is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 1. January seven of every year is hereby declared as a special nonworking holiday in the Province of Camiguin to commemorate its charter day anniversary."

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
