[REPUBLIC ACT No. 9499]

- AN ACT ALLOWING FILIPINO WORLD WAR II VETERANS TO CONTINUE RECEIVING PHILIPPINE GOVERNMENT PENSIONS AND BENEFITS NOTWITHSTANDING SIMILAR PENSIONS AND BENEFITS PROVIDED BY THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT, THEREBY AMENDING REPUBLIC ACT NO. 694.8 AMENDED.
- Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Compress assembled:

SECTION 1. Short Title. – This Act shall be known as the "Filipino World War II Veterans Pensions and Benefits Act of 2008." State to recognize and reward the courage and heroism of Filipino World War II veterans by granting them pensions and benefits even when similar pensions and benefits are already provided by the United States Government.

SEC. 3. Amendment of Section 10 of Republic Act No. 6948, as Amended. - Section 10 of Republic Act No. 6948, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 10. Eligibility. - A veteran as defined in Section 2(a) of this Act who is at least sixtyfive (65) years old shall be paid an old-age pension of Five thousand peace (P5,000,00) monthly for life, unless he is actually receiving a similar pension for the same consideration from other government

SEC. 4. Amendment of Section 11 of Republic Act No. 6948, as Amended. - Section 11 of Republic Act No. 6948, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"SRC. 11. Pension of Surviving Spouse.—The surviving spouse of a veteran as defined in Section 2(a) of this Act shall, regardless of age, be vaid a pension of Five thousand peose (Ps,000.00) monthly until heighe remarries or dies, unless he/she is actually receiving a similar pension for the same catually receiving a similar pension for the same funds. SEC. 5. Appropriation. - The funding to carry out this Act shall be included in the annual General Appropriations

Act.

SEC. 6. Repealing Clause. – All laws, decrees, orders, rules and regulations or other issuances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed

or modified accordingly.

SEC. 7. Separability Clause. — If any portion or provision of this Act is declared unconstitutional, the remainder of this Act or any provisions not affected thereby shall remain in force and effect.

SEC. 8. Effectivity. - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days following the completion of its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation in the Philipoines.
