C. COMMISSION ON APPOINTMENTS

STRATEGIC OBJECTIVES

MANDATE

The Commission on Appointments (CA) is vested by the 1987 Philippine Constitution with the power to approve or disapprove appointments made by the President of the Philippines, the confirmation of which is required under the Constitution. This power shall be discharged with impartiality, without partisan consideration and with only one impelling motive, which is the harmonious and efficient functioning of the government.

VISION

The Secretariat is an efficient and competent arm of the Commission on Appointments for the effective dispatch of its constitutional mandate. Towards this end, it shall focus on the primacy of service to the public, in general, and the Members of the Commission, in particular. It shall attain the highest ethical and moral standards of public service and human relations. It shall be an instrument of change for national development and progress.
