Special Provision(s)

1. Release and Use of Fund. The amount appropriated herein shall be used for rehabilitation, repair and reconstruction works and activities of areas affected by disasters and calamities, both natural and man-made including the areas devastated by typhoons "Yolanda", "Santi", "Odette", "Pablo", "Sendong", "Vinta" and "Labuyo", the 7.2 magnitude earthquake in Bohol and Cebu and the seige and unrest in Zamboanga City. Release of funds under this Purpose shall be made directly to the appropriate implementing departments/agencies and/or concerned local government unit in accordance with the recommendation of the NDRRNC and approval of the President of the Philippines, subject to Section 63 of this Act:

Any government official, employee and person who shall misuse any amount of this Fund which has been placed under his/her control/administration shall suffer the maximum penalty imposed under the Revised Penal Code, R.A. No. 3019, R.A. No. 7080 and other appropriate penal laws.

To ensure accountability and transparency, the DBM shall post in its official website the releases from the Rehabilitation and Reconstruction Program indicating the recipient department/agency, the amount and the purpose. Likewise, recipient departments/agencies implementing rehabilitation and reconstruction of infrastructure projects shall post in their respective website the description of the projects, the costing and the winning bidders, including status of its implementation. Recipient departments/agencies providing non-infrastructure projects shall post in their website the status of their fund utilization and a narrative description of the project accomplishments. The DBM and the concerned agencies shall submit to the House Committee on Appropriations and the Senate Committee on Finance a copy of these reports.
