## [REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11060]

AN ACT SEPARATING THE KALBAY NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL ANNEX IN BARANGAY SUGAL, MUNICIPALITY OF JOSE ABAD SANTOS, PROVINCE OF DAVAO OCCIDENTAL FROM THE KALBAY NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL, CONVERTING IT INTO AN INDEPENDENT NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS EMELIANO S. FONTANARES SR. NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The Kalbay National High School Annex in Barangay Sugal, Municipality of Jose Abad Santos, Province

of Davao Occidental is hereby separated from the Kalbay National High School, and converted into an independent national high school to be known as Emeliano S. Fontanares Sr. National High School.

- SEC. 2. All personnel, assets, liabilities, and records of the Kalbay National High School Annex are hereby transferred to and absorbed by the Emeliano S. Fontanares Sr. National High School.
- SEC. 3. The Secretary of Education shall immediately include in the Department's program the operationalization of the Emeliano S. Fontanares Sr. National High School, the initial funding of which shall be charged against the current year's appropriation of the Kalbay National High School Annex. Thereafter, the amount necessary for the continued operation of the school shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.
- SEC. 4. The Secretary of Education shall formulate the rules and regulations necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act within one hundred twenty (120) days after its effectivity.
- SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
